Ms van Middelkoop has been serving quality black, green and herbal loose-leaf teas with her Devonshire and high tea menu for several years.

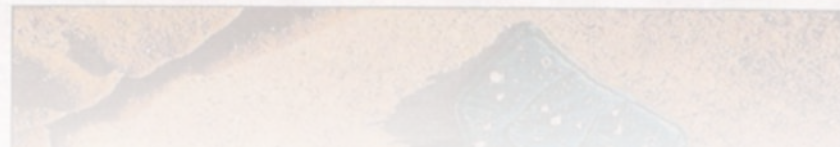
The Mermaid Moments range, which will be released to an international market, is based on organic Indian, Chinese, Japanese and South African teas.
